The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Identity Data includes first name, last name and title.
- **Location/Contact Data** includes postcode, address, delivery address, email address and telephone numbers.
- **Technical Data** includes internet protocol (IP) address, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform and other technology on the devices you use to access this website.

We also collect, use and share **Aggregated Data** such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose. Aggregated Data may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as this data does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity.



How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- You have attended an event
- You have completed a feedback form
- You have contacted us to request information.

We also receive personal information indirectly, from the following sources in the following scenarios:

- Where a third party has passed details for us to make contact with regards to a project
- Technical Data from analytics providers such as Google or Microsoft based outside the EU.

We may share this information with clients, which will be stated on any forms through which you provide information.

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- (a) Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting lynne@kevinmurrayassociates.com
- (b) We have a contractual obligation.
- (c) We have a legal obligation.
- (d) We have a legitimate interest.

Purposes for which we will use your personal data

We have set out below, in a table format, a description of all the ways we plan to use your personal data, and which of the legal bases we rely on to do so. We have also identified what our legitimate interests are where appropriate.

Note that we may process your personal data for more than one lawful ground depending on the specific purpose for which we are using your data. Please *contact us* if you need details about the specific legal ground we are relying on to process your personal data where more than one ground has been set out in the table below.

How we store your personal information

Your information is securely stored.

We keep contact details, personal identifiers and images for 2 years within KMA's secure cloud storage (Microsoft SharePoint) and other hard drive locations. We will then dispose your information by deleting this from the SharePoint and other hard drive locations.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
